THE CITY OF JUSTIN FALL SWEEP

THE CITY OF JUSTIN WILL HOLD OUR FALL SWEEP EVENT ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 5TH, 2019 FROM 8:00AM TO 12:00PM.

Residents of Justin can bring their bulk trash to City Hall during that time for disposal at no cost. The roll-off dumpsters are available until they are at capacity, so plan to arrive early.

Proof of residency in Justin City limits will be required via driver's license or water bill. This Cleanup Event will include bulk trash, electronic waste/recycling, document shredding, and tire disposal.

Disposal of the following items are free of charge.

E-waste includes:

- Cell phones
- Laptops (with or without hard drive)
- Computer Towers (with or without hard drive)
- Monitors, Keyboards, and Mice
- Power Cords and Speakers
- Desktop Printers and Scanners

Paper shredding includes all sensitive documents such as:

- Banking info, checks, statements, records
- Payroll information
- Financial statements
- Insurance information

Additional \$20 Disposal/Processing Fee for each item:

- TV's up to 65"
- CRT Computer Monitors
- Hard Drive Destruction (off site)-For a certificate of destruction

No need to remove paper clips, staples, file folders, or rubber bands...we can shred those!

DIY RAIN BARREL CLASS

ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 12TH TEXAS A&M AGRILIFE RESEARCH WILL BE HOSTING A CLASS AT JUSTIN CITY HALL.

This program covers the basics and benefits of rainwater harvesting and the effects stormwater has on the environment. Participants will learn how to collect and utilize rainwater at home and have the opportunity to construct their very own 55 gallon rain barrel. Rain barrels are recycled food-grade containers and are roughly 24" wide by 36" tall.
