SPRING CLEANUP EVENT

THE CITY OF JUSTIN WILL HOLD OUR SPRING CLEANUP EVENT ON SATURDAY, APRIL 4TH, 2019 FROM 8:00AM TO 12:00PM.

Residents of Justin can bring their bulk trash to City Hall during that time for disposal at no cost. The roll-off dumpsters are available until they are at capacity, so plan to arrive early. Proof of residency in Justin City limits will be required via driver's license or water bill.

This Cleanup Event will include bulk trash, disposal, electronic waste/recycling, document shredding, and tire disposal. Disposal of the following items are free of charge.

E-waste includes:

- Cell phones
- Laptops (with or without hard drive)
- Computer Towers (with or without hard drive)
- Monitors
- Keyboards
- Mice Power Cords
- Speakers Desktop
- Desktop scanners

Paper shredding includes all sensitive documents such as:

- Banking info
- Checks
- Statements
- Records
- Payroll information
- Financial statements
- Insurance information

Additional \$20 Disposal/Processing Fee for each item:

- TV's up to 65" CRT
- Computer Monitors

Additional \$10 Disposal/Processing Fee for:

- Hard Drive Destruction (off site)-For a certificate of destruction

No need to remove paper clips, staples, file folders, or rubber bands...we can shred those!

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE PROGRAM

NEXT PICKUP DAY IS TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2020

This allows Justin residents to properly discard items such as paint, motor oil, insecticides, pool chemicals, and other household chemicals which are not accepted by regular trash collection services and are prohibited in landfills. In order to get signed up for the monthly collection list, residents can visit HHW's website at <http://hhwsolutions.com/justin/> or call (972) 440-2040. Each month, on the appointed collection day, residents can leave their household hazardous waste items on their front porch in the morning before 8:00a.m. and the items will be removed by the end of the day.
